- 1) Submit NURSBS Application Form
- 2) Complete Secondary Admission Process
- 3) Submit Transcripts from all colleges attended
- 4) If selected, complete pre-admission requirements
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher required
- Application dates for Fall admission:
  - o October 1 October 15
- **Application dates for Spring admission:** o March 1 - March 15
