- 1) Submit NURSBS [Application Form](#)
- 2) Complete Secondary Admission Process
- 3) Submit Transcripts from all colleges attended
- 4) If selected, complete pre-admission requirements
 - Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher required
 - Application dates for Fall admission:
 - October 1 – October 15 _____
 - Application dates for Spring admission:
 - March 1 – March 15 _____

PBHL Application Process

- 1) Complete all Pre-PBHL Course Requirements²
- 2) Have a 2.5 or higher University of Arkansas GPA
- 3) Submit PBHL [Application Form](#)
 - All students, including transfer students must complete at least 12 credit hours at the University of Arkansas with a minimum of 2.5 GPA
 - Submit applications to the Public Health program once all Pre-Public Health prerequisite course are complete²
