The application process includes:
 Students must complete the application to teacher education through the Teacher Education Office during spring semester of sophomore year. This includes completing and passing the criminal background check and also passing Praxis Core academic subjects test or equivalent tests by meeting or exceeding the Arkansas Department of Education cut-off scores.
 Submission of application.
 Submission of letter of intent.
 Submission of transcripts for all coursework.

Another background check will be required prior to graduation in order to be eligible for licensure.
